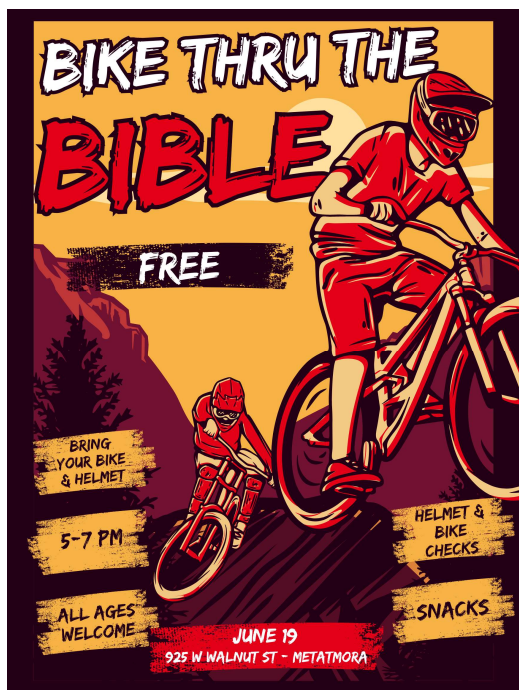
Update for Tuesday night Bible studies - June 9th the Women's Bible Study will return to the Lucado Study Lesson 44; and the Men will begin Studying Acts.
