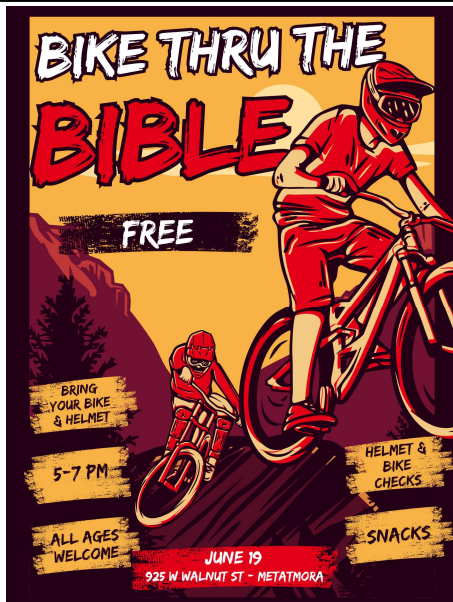
June Dining Out - is on Thursday, June 11th at 6pm at Monical's in Washington.

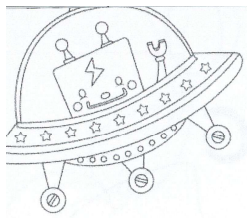
Father's Day newsletter error - Father's Day was notated as being on June 14th and that is wrong. Father's Day for 2026 is June 21, 2026.
